



Get Bio Pak Product Safety Statement

Effective: January 1, 2022

Get Bio Pak, a manufacturer of Visually Paper Cups and Containers, is committed to providing customers with safe products which are compliant with appropriate laws and regulations.

To ensure compliance, samples of finished products are sent to third-party testing facilities on a bi-annual basis, using only CPSC approved laboratories. While our cups and containers are not intended for children, our smaller cups adorned with children's décor can be considered "children's products." Therefore, our products are subject to the rigorous requirements of California's Proposition 65 and relevant testing for children's products, in addition to other U.S. FDA and EU requirements. The battery of testing that our products are subjected to includes extraction, FSSE testing, product appropriate 16 CFR 1500 mechanical hazards testing, phthalates, lead, and heavy metals. Additionally, samples are third-party microbiological contamination tested and mold contamination tested on a bi-monthly basis.

Get Bio Pak products are free of BPA and PCBs. To comply with regulations and further protect our customers, our cups and containers are labeled with unique traceable product identifiers and meet all applicable labeling requirements. Currently, Get Bio Pak products do not warrant labeling to comply with California Proposition 65.

The Get Bio Pak facility is certified according to the ISO Standard FSSC 22000 Food Safety scheme. A HACCP plan and variety of pre-requisite programs are employed to support this certification and include a Sanitation & Security Program, Supplier controls, Chemical Control, Receiving, Storage and Shipping, Traceability and Recall, and Pest Control. Get Bio Pak is also subjected to annual sanitation compliance audits. All certifications and audit reports are available on our website.

Get Bio Pak is socially responsible concerning employment practices. We submit to periodic social compliance audits to evaluate our employment documentation, facility policies and procedures, compliance to environmental regulations, and health and safety practices. The audit standard is the globally accepted Sedex Members Ethical Trade Audit (SMETA) requirements, and that report is available on our website.

Finally, Get Bio Pak is committed to protecting all customers from unauthorized access of sensitive, confidential, and proprietary information. As a standard practice, we do not disclose sensitive, confidential or proprietary information not generally known to the public, provided to us throughout the order process.
